We had four new applications come in recently but they did not pass the lien checks, so they were not accepted.

Reserve applications: We have two new applications at this time and they will be interviewed early in January. With the addition of two more reserve officers, we will be at the **desired number** of reserves.

Training: Our next training will be Policies and Procedures that was originally scheduled for November, but due to the numerous details for that month, it needed to be moved. Chief Ruth generally does that portion of the winter's training. We will need to check with him for a date and time in January.

Department Grounds: This summer, we will add three or four flowering pear trees along the west side of the Police Department building. We did plant one when we first started the grounds improvement along with the large flower box. The finance committee will have to approve the funds to cover the cost. We hope to complete this Reserve project in early spring.

Awards and Recognition Dinner: This was our **12th consecutive** event. It was well-attended by sixty reserves and guests. The key note speaker was Dave Maurer, who is station manager and news anchor at WSGW Radio. Mr. Maurer has a deep knowledge of the city as well the police and fire departments. Mr. Maurer has been with WSGW for 35 years. He was an **outstanding speaker** and we were very fortunate to have him. As in past years, Chief Robert Ruth was Master of Ceremonies and kept the program on track.

The Community Safety Award was presented to Mr. Mike Hagen, the City Streets Supervisor. This is the first time an award of this type has ever been given to anyone other than a reserve at the Reserve Awards and Recognition Event. The Reserve Unit was significantly involved in recognizing Mike for his outstanding work. Mike and his crew make our job at each event much safer by handling street barricades efficiently. The award was presented by Chief Robert Ruth, Mayor Dennis Browning, and Mayor Pro-Tem Floyd Kloc.

Reserve Officer of the Year: This year's Officer of the Year is Jeff Dilts. He is one of our younger reserves and is very active and is at most reserve activities throughout the city. Congratulations!
