


Saginaw Police Department – Reserve Unit News Letter March 2018

Training: Glock 9 was completed in conjunction with the new red gel spray that replaces the old pepper type spray. Officer Roger Pate led those two sessions and as usual, he did a great job. We will have M4 rifle training on Sunday, April 15, 2018. We should plan on a start time of 3:00pm.

Temple Theater: The unit served at that venue Saturday, **March 24** and again on Sunday, **March 25, 2018**. It was 20 degrees and windy for Saturday's event but we were able to handle the event well.

Detroit (Tiger Stadium) 1912 to 1999: September 27, 1999 was the last game played at the corner of Michigan and Trumbull. The Tigers played the Kansas City Royals. A grand slam home run, hit by Detroit's Robert Fick, was the last hit, the last home run, and the last RBI at the stadium with the Tigers winning it with a score of 8 to 2. Babe Ruth also hit his 700 hundredth home run at Tiger Stadium. In total, there were 11,111 home runs hit during its time and Fick's was the last.

New Reserves: We always are looking for new people for the Unit. There will be a lot of events throughout the summer months.

Saginaw Police Awards Ceremonies: This yearly event recognizes department officers and other people connected to the department recognizing them for their outstanding contributions. This event will take place in the **Ball Room** at the **Temple Theater** on Thursday, **May 10, 2018 at 10:00am**.
